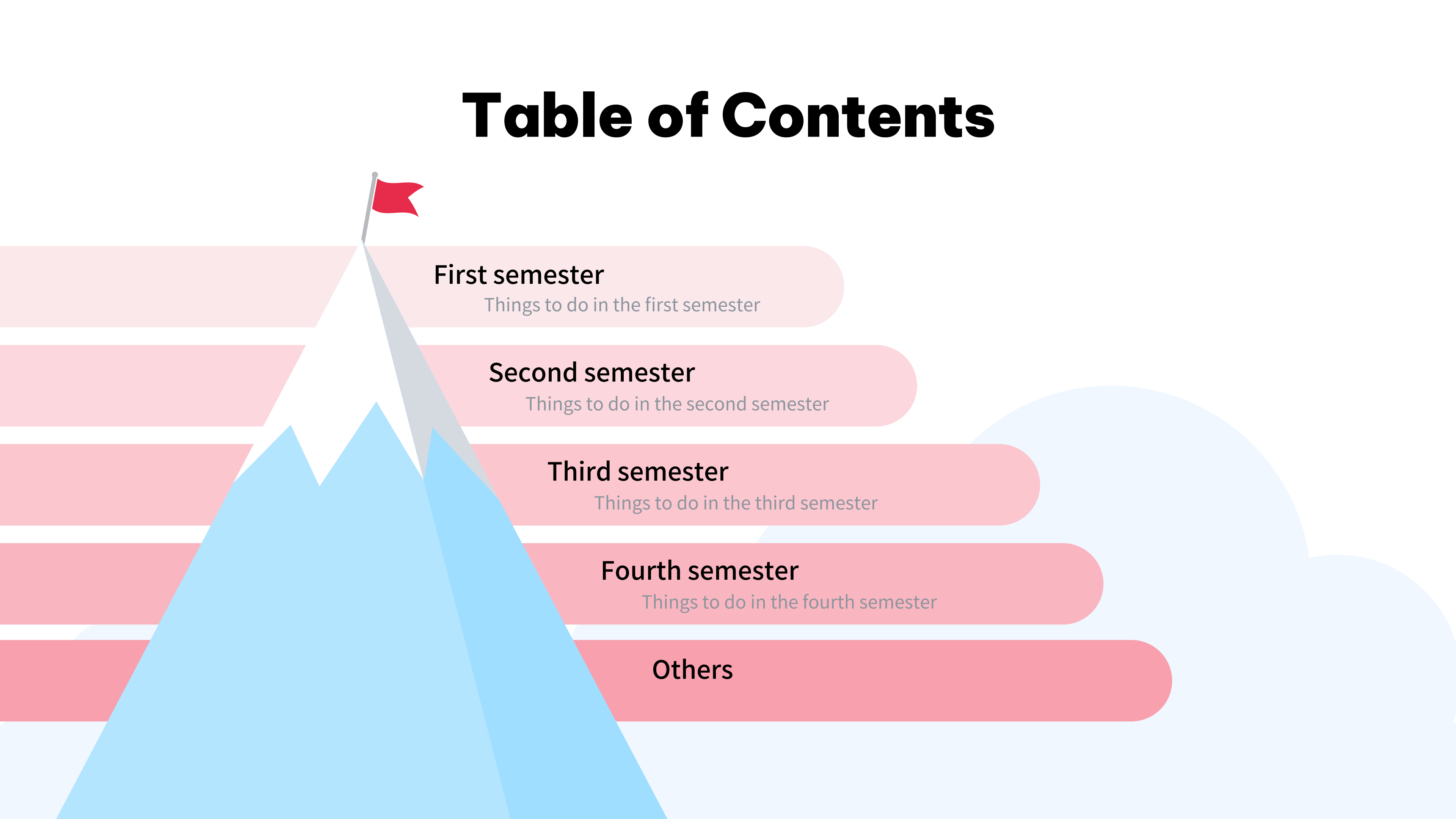

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# Things to do in the first semester

## Take supplementary credits

Students who majored in a different field during their undergraduate studies are required to take supplementary credits.

Up to 9 credits may be taken from the undergraduate curriculum of the English major. However, practical English courses (taught by native speakers), practicum courses, and first-year courses are excluded.

The requirement for supplementary credits will be determined by the department faculty after reviewing the student's previous coursework.

## Explore Thesis Topics and Potential Advisors

## (During the break) Take Foreign Language Test

Students are required to take a foreign language test during the break. However, students who meet the exemption criteria below within two years from the application date may be exempt from taking the test.

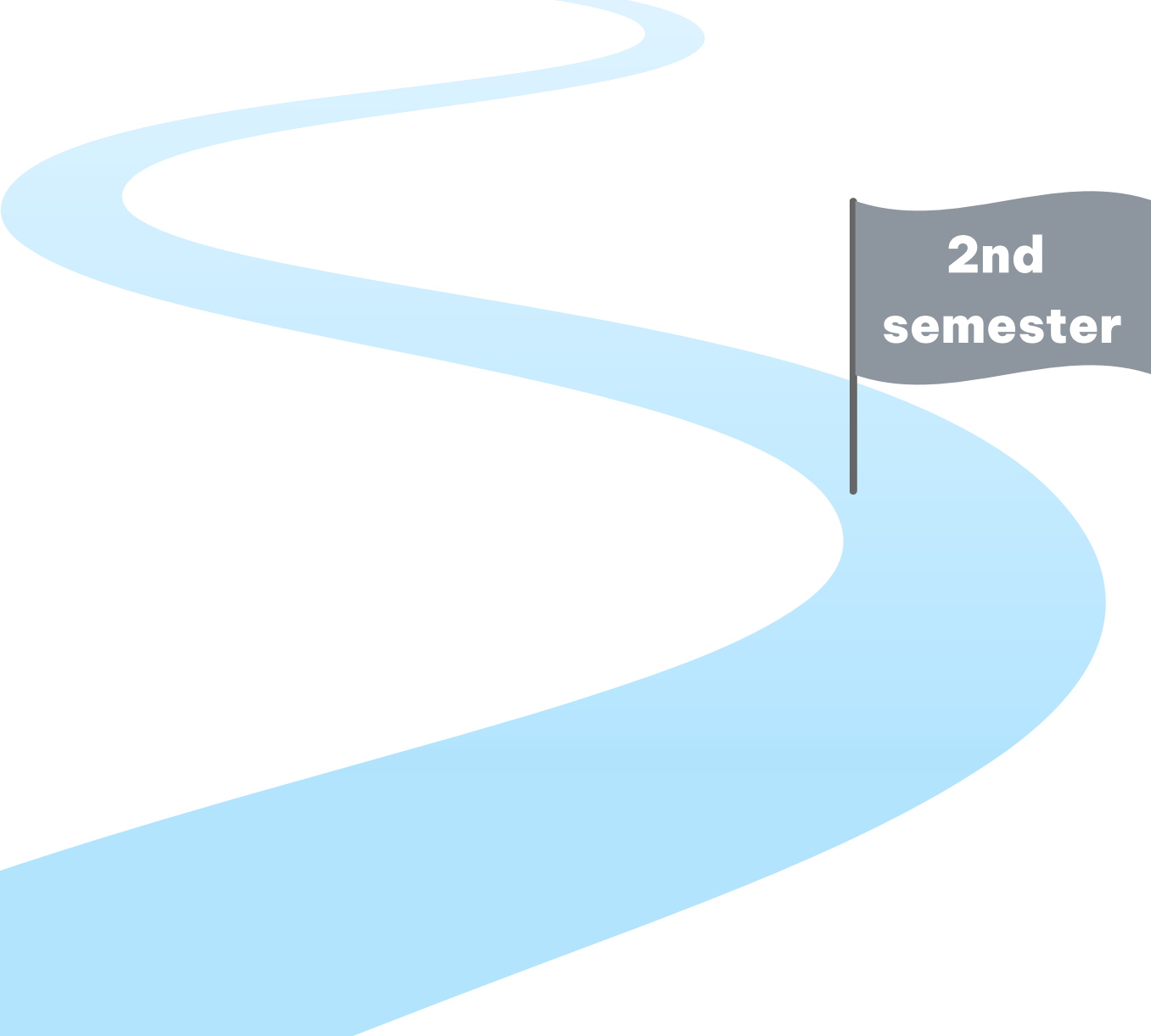

## Complete Supplementary Credits

Students must complete 9 supplementary credits by the end of the second semester.

## Select an Academic Advisor

Students must select an academic advisor within their first two semesters. When requesting an advisor, students must provide their student ID, name, and intended research topic or direction, and make the request in a formal and respectful manner.

After receiving the advisor's approval, students must notify the department office of their advisor selection.

## Submit Thesis Proposal

Students must prepare a thesis proposal and consult with their academic advisor for approval before submission. The final version of the thesis proposal must be submitted to the department office by the deadline.

The proposal must be typed; handwritten submissions are not accepted.

## **(During the Break) Take the Comprehensive Examination**

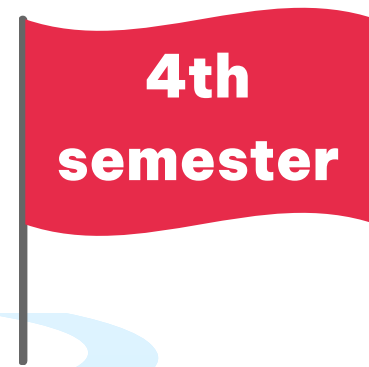
Students may take the comprehensive examination after completing the required credits and with the recommendation of their academic advisor: at least 18 credits for the master's program, 27 credits for the doctoral program, and 45 credits for the integrated master's–doctoral program.

The examination must cover at least two subject areas for the master's program and at least three for the doctoral program. One subject area must be in the advisor's field, while the remaining areas may be chosen by the student.

To pass, students must earn at least 50 in each subject area and an overall average of 70 or higher. If a student has an overall average of 70 or higher but receives less than 50 in any subject area, the student may retake only that subject area within one year.

But, Students with a cumulative GPA of 4.2 or higher are exempt from the comprehensive examination.

# Things to do in the fourth semester



## Begin Writing the Thesis

Students must begin writing their thesis under the guidance of their academic advisor. They must conduct data collection and analysis in accordance with their research plan and prepare a draft of the thesis. Students must also regularly consult with their advisor to review and refine their work.

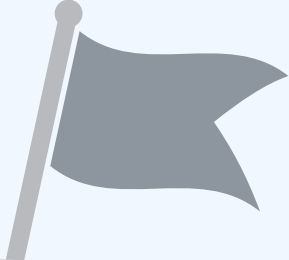

## **Supplementary Credits**

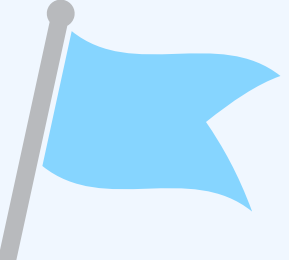
Students may take up to 6 supplementary credits per semester.
